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This is a flexible multi focus alphabet activity for early learners. It includes strips of upper case letters, full alphabet. After printing on cardstock or regular paper, the teacher cuts the lines of letters into strips, horizontally.

Children can:

- Cut the strips into separate letters, on the dotted lines, saying the name of the letter as they do so.
- Sort the cut letters. Use only 2 sets of letters to sort, for beginners.
- Play a Memory game. Choose pairs of 6 to 8 letters, place randomly upside down in a grid. Children turn 2 letters over at a time, looking for a match.
- Find the letters - scatter a collection of letters face side up on the floor or table. Direct a child to find all the Ks, or Bs etc. How many did you find?
- Make a letter collage by pasting a collection of letters on construction paper, creatively or in order.
- Find the letters in their name.

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
