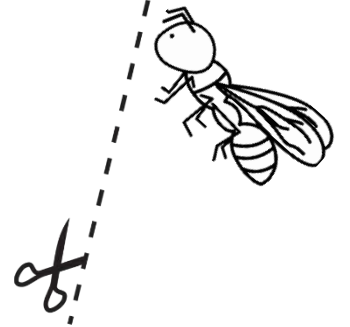
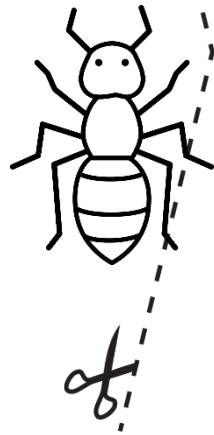
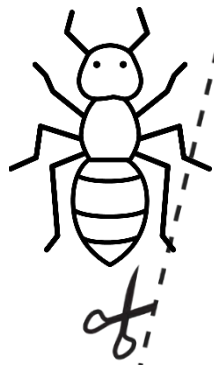


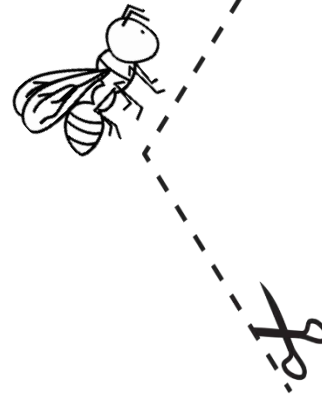
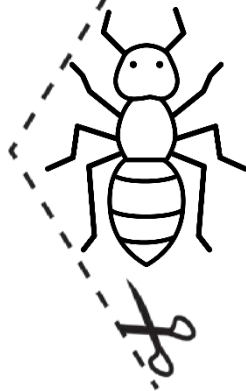
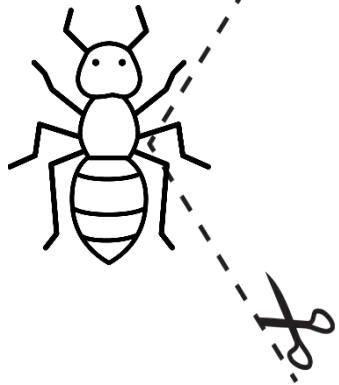
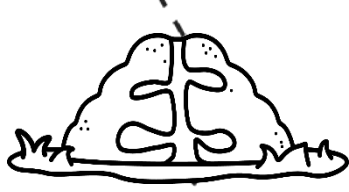
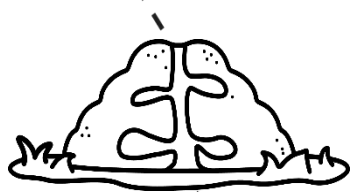












Here is a set of printables to use to develop and practice early cutting skills. Lines are straight, curved, and zigzag.
